Memorial Services

To assist you in planning the service to celebrate the life of your loved one, below are some details to consider:

If your loved one has completed a pre-planning checklist, please provide it to the Covenant office. If you would like Covenant to coordinate the service, contact the Church office.

Reserve date and time

As soon as you are able, please contact the church office to inquire about availability of both the church building and the pastor for your preferred date and time.

Flowers

Families often purchase flower arrangements through local florists and have them delivered to the church before a service. Flowers may also be received from other friends and family and delivered to the church. Following the service, the family is encouraged to take flowers with them though plans can be made to leave some flowers for an upcoming Sunday worship service.

Music

Please contact the church office as soon as possible if you would like to hire a musician to play organ or piano for the service, and if you would like to have a soloist or accompanist for special music. There is a fee associated with hiring any musician. (see fee schedule below)

Live stream service

The service may be livestreamed through our YouTube channel. Following the service, a YouTube video would be available to share. If you desire, the livestream/video can be made private so only people with the link can access it. There is a fee associated with livestreaming a service. (See fee schedule below.)

Photos

If you'd like to display a slideshow of photos on the narthex monitor, please provide a **maximum** of 30 photos to the church office on a flash drive **at least four days** before the service. The best file format is jpg. (We CANNOT do this the day before or day of the service.)

If you'd like to have photo boards or mementos on display in the narthex, please let the office know **at least four days** before the service how many tables and/or easels will be required.

To keep the focus on God and the promise of resurrection we do not share photos or videos on the screen in the sanctuary during the service.

Reception/food: If you would like a reception at Covenant, the family is responsible for ordering and purchasing the food to be served. Covenant can provide a team of volunteers for room set up, serving, and clean up. The family is encouraged to take any/all leftovers. Covenant usually has some individual to-go containers at the church which can be used. If the family is not interested in the leftovers, arrangements can be made to take them to a local homeless shelter.

Bulletin: The church can provide a worship bulletin including obituary and a picture. Bulletins are normally printed the day before the service. Please submit any information needed for the bulletin to the church staff at least one week before the day of the service.

Fees: Funeral directors often facilitate payment of the necessary fees/honorariums connected with a service including pastors, musicians, and a/v operators. If you are not working with a director, please confirm fees with the church office.
