



Motion to change masking policy from “masks required” to “masks recommended”
Passed by Session on March 22, 2022 in agreement with the Re-opening Task Force

*Face masks are now **recommended** (not required) when in the building.*

As the Covid-19 pandemic continues on its eventual path toward endemic status, Covenant will maintain a commitment to safety for all and a commitment to the common good. We ask that care be taken by individuals using the spaces at Covenant, whether for worship or other uses, to consider the vulnerable in our actions so that we can care for the least. Masks and social distancing are still recommended, though not required. Each group gathering together may determine whether masks must be worn. Conditions will continue to be monitored and mitigations will be scaled up and down as conditions change because the pandemic isn't over yet.
